Suboptimal example:

"I'm Katja Poppenhaeger. I'm working on the rotation and activity of a sample of stars with asteroseismic ages. Right now I'm collecting highresolution spectra of those stars to measure their chromospheric emission. I'm using data from Calar Alto and the LBT."

Who are you and what do you work on?

Improved example:

"I'm Katja Poppenhaeger, I'm a professor for Astrophysics at Potsdam University. I'm investigating how stars spin down as they get older. Right now there's a controversy if they stop spinning down at an old age or not, and I'm looking at stars with well-known ages that will tell us the difference. We care about that because it influences how habitable planets around these stars can be."
